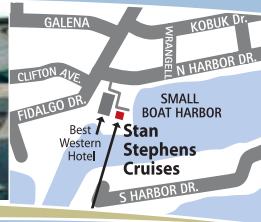

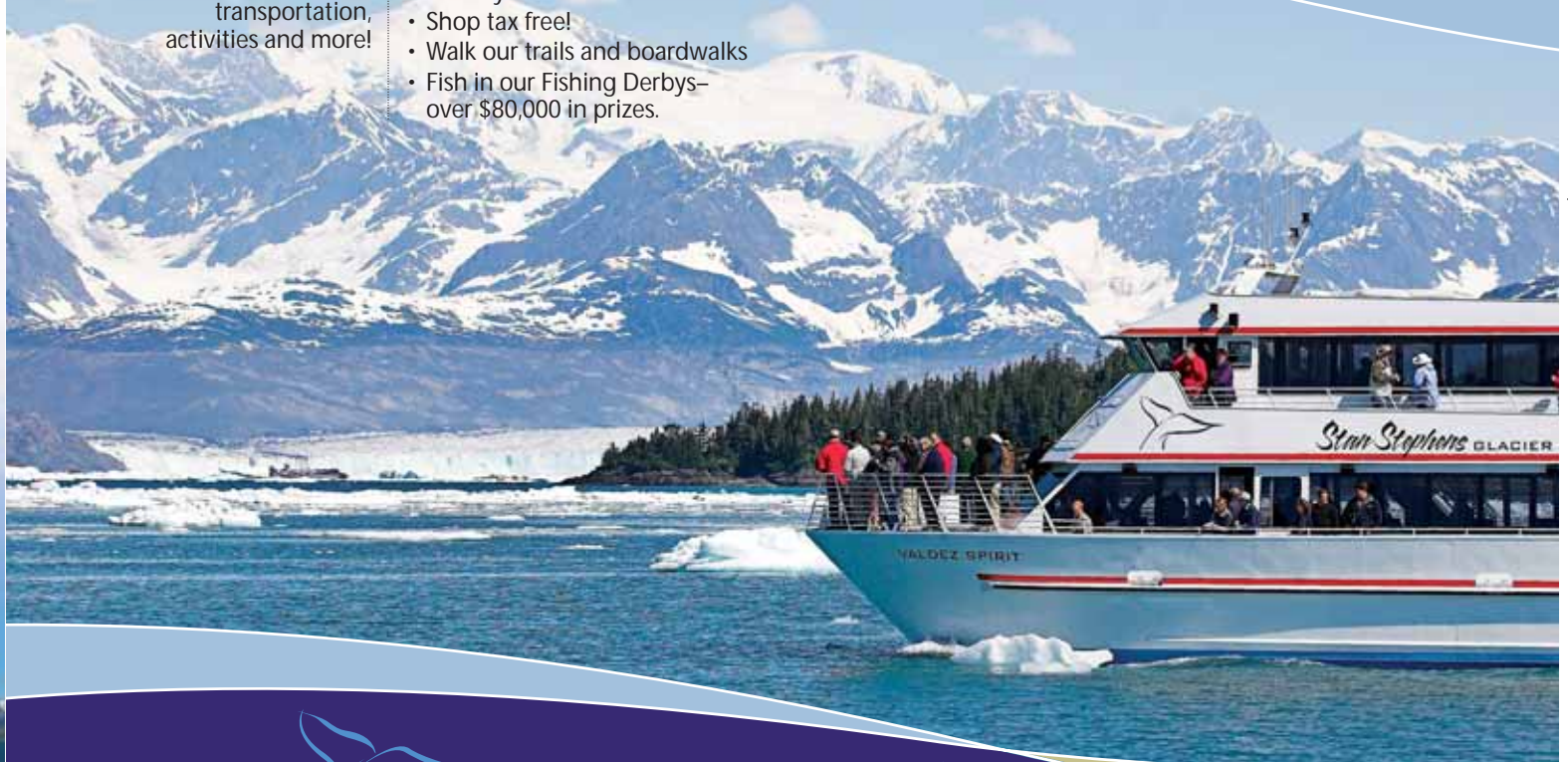

- Children Rates are for persons age 3-12, children 2 and under are free of charge.
- To meet regulations we will request the first and last name of each person in your party.

Deposits:

- A deposit of \$50/adult and \$25/child is requested at the time of booking to confirm reservations.
- Full payment is due 30 days prior to travel.

Cancellation:

- Full refund will be given if the reservation is cancelled 16-30 days in advance.
- 50% refund will be given if the reservation is cancelled 8-15 days in advance.
- No refund will be given if the reservation is cancelled less than 7 days in advance.

TOUR 1 Columbia and Meares Glacier Excursion

June 1 - August 31 - Daily
Departs 10:00 am • Arrives 7:00 pm

Tour Rates: Adult: \$147 (+ fees), Child: \$73 (+ fees)

On board this 9 hour journey you will have a chance to view ice calving from Meares Glacier as well as the huge icebergs at Columbia Glacier. Enroute you will view the wildlife of the Sound including Pt. Bull Head Sea Lion haulout. Learn about the mining, oil, earthquake, and fishing history and hear stories about the first people to explore and live in the Sound. On board a lunch as well as an afternoon soup snack is served. ♿

What to Wear: For all of our tours we recommend that all guests dress in warm layers, as the temperatures at the glaciers will generally be in the 40°F range (4.5°C).

TOUR 2 Columbia Glacier Cruise

May 15 - September 15 - Daily
Departs 12:00 noon • Arrives 6:30-7:00 pm

Tour Rates: Adult: \$112 (+ fees), Child: \$56 (+ fees)

This 6½ to 7 hour journey through Prince William Sound features the amazing icebergs from Columbia Glacier. On board you will have a chance to view the Sound's wildlife including Pt. Bull Head Sea Lion haulout. You will learn about the mining, oil, earthquake, and fishing history and you will hear stories about the first people to explore and live in the Sound. On board a soup and bagel lunch is served. ♿
